

WIRRAWAY HOMESTEAD

GENERAL RULES

1. Stay in camp vicinity unless you have staff permission to leave.
2. Be considerate to others, and the environment, at all times.
3. Campers may only enter their own bunkhouse, other bunkhouses are out of bounds.
4. Cigarettes, alcohol & non-prescription drugs not permitted at camp.
5. Bunkhouses are for quiet activities, all "horseplay" should take place in other areas.
6. Wirraway staff houses and accommodation are out of bounds to campers except for emergencies. Campers should stay in the camp paddock which encases the building unless accompanied by a staff member.
7. To go in among the horses can be dangerous. Pat them over the fence, but that is close enough! (They like to be patted on the neck or shoulder, not around the face.) Don't feed any of the animals without staff permission.
8. Swimming pool, trampolines and climbing tower can be used only when supervised by a staff member.
9. Drinking water: All taps in bathrooms are rainwater. Please don't waste water. Drinking fountains are on the dining room verandah and in the horse area. Water from garden taps is not safe to drink.
10. All vehicles are out of bounds for campers.
11. Please keep off the garden beds and treat activity equipment with care and respect.
12. Campers are expected to obey all reasonable instructions given to them by the Wirraway staff.
13. Campers should not bring to camp items which could pose a risk to others (e.g. pocket knives, matches & lighters etc.)
14. To encourage a sense of community: It is recommended that campers not bring electronic devices such as MP3 players to camp and that mobile phones, if permitted, should be for emergency use only.

SAFETY:

1. In an EMERGENCY (eg. Bushfire), everyone should gather in the Dining Room. The alarm will be raised by a continuous ringing of the bell. Further instructions will be given when everyone is assembled.
2. All electrical fences are either white or orange tape, do not touch them!
3. Snakes: If you see one, do NOT approach it. Notify a staff member if it is near the camp buildings.
4. Sunburn: Remember you will be outdoors much of the time. Make sure you protect yourself with a hat and sunscreen. (Sunscreen is available)
