

WIRRAWAY HOMESTEAD

GENERAL RULES

1. Stay in camp vicinity unless you have permission to leave.
2. Be considerate to others, and the environment, at all times.
3. Girls' bunkhouse for girls only, boys' bunkhouse for boys
AT ALL TIMES!
4. Wirraway is a Cigarette, Alcohol & Drug free zone.
5. Bunkhouses are for quiet activities, all "horseplay" should take place in other areas.
6. Wirraway staff houses and accommodation are out of bounds to campers (except in an emergency where help is needed).
7. To go in amongst the horses can be dangerous. Pat them over the fence, but that is close enough! Please don't feed them; this puts you and them at risk.
8. Swimming pool and trampolines can be used only when supervised by a Wirraway staff member or teacher (The pool must be set up and tested first by a Wirraway staff member).
9. Drinking water: All taps in bathrooms are drinking water. Drinking fountains are on the dining room verandah, outside the tack shed and the climbing wall.
10. All vehicles are out of bounds.
11. Please keep off the garden beds.
12. Campers are expected to obey all reasonable instructions given to them by the Wirraway staff.
13. Do not bring valuables with you to camp.

SAFETY:

1. In an EMERGENCY (eg. Bushfire), everyone should gather on the Playing Field. The alarm will be raised by a siren. Further instructions will be given when everyone is assembled.
2. Electric fences are either white or orange tape, do not touch them!
3. Snakes: If you see one, do NOT approach it. Notify a staff member if it is near the camp buildings.
4. Sunburn: Remember you will be outdoors much of the time. Make sure you protect yourself with a hat and sunscreen.
